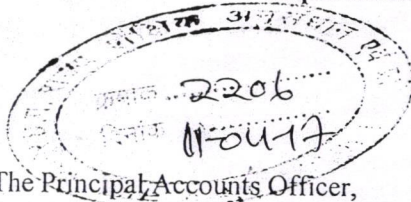

Subject: - Release of 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment as Recurring Central assistance to the Government of Chhattisgarh for the year 2016-17 under the Scheme of Teacher Education.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Govt. of Chhattisgarh vide letter no. 2017/SCERT/CSS/LIC/882 dt. 02.03.2017 regarding release of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment as Recurring Central assistance for 2016-17 under the Scheme of Teacher Education to the State Government of Chhattisgarh .

2. In pursuance of Ministry's Sanction Order of even no. dated 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2016 regarding released of Rs. 457.14 lakh as 1<sup>st</sup> installment of Recurring Central Assistance to the State for 2016-17. The detailed institution wise break-up of approved budget and released Central assistance of 1<sup>st</sup> installment as recurring Central assistance by the Ministry for 2016-17 to the State Govt. of Chhattisgarh are as under:-

As per received expenditure statement from the State Govt. of Chhattisgarh, Ministry has now, considered the proposal of Rs. 362.42 lakh for release of 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment for 2016-17 in r/o Salary component of DIETs only. The proposal for release of 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment in r/o programme & other Activities would be considered as and when obtain the utilization Certification from the State Govt. against released of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment. The details are given below:-

The 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of Rs. 362.42 lakh as Recurring Central assistance for the year 2016-17 is to be released in three Components i.e. General, SCSP & STSP Head for the year 2016-17. It is, therefore, a sum of Rs. 362.42 lakhs is being released as per the following details:-

5. I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India to the payment of **Rs. 177.19 lakhs** (Rupees One Crore Seventy Seven Lakh and Nineteen Thousands Only) under **General Head** to the Government of Chhattisgarh as 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of recurring Central assistance to meet the expenditure on payment of salary and programme for the year 2016-17 under the Scheme of Teacher Education for DIETs, CTEs, IASEs and SCERT.
6. The amount sanctioned under STSP Head is being issued separately.
7. The above grant of Central assistance shall be subject to the following conditions:-
- (i) Central assistance will be utilized in conformity with the guidelines for the scheme circulated to State Governments vide this Department's D.O. letter No. 44-2/2012-EE-9, dated 12-7-2012, and any other guidelines that may be circulated by the Department from time to time.
  - (ii) Expenditure on the training programme under other specific schemes (like SSA, EGS / AIE, etc.), shall be met from the funds sanctioned under those schemes and not from the funds sanctioned under Teacher Education Scheme.
  - (iii) A copy of every order of State Government according administrative approval or financial sanction for any item of recurring expenditure (including orders concerning posts) in connection with the above institutions will be endorsed to this Department.
  - (iv) State Government shall abide by the terms & conditions of the MOU executed by the Ministry and the State Government, and any further guidelines which may be issued by the Ministry from time to time.
  - (v) The amount of grant shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance out of the grant, if any, at the end of 2015-16, shall be refunded by the State Government after the close of the financial year, unless permission is granted for its being carried forward for utilization for the same purpose during the following financial year.
  - (vi) State Govt. shall regularly submit half-yearly progress cum utilization report under the Teacher Education Scheme. Utilization report of amount being released by this sanction letter shall be forwarded by the State Govt. at the earliest, and in any case within three months from close of the financial year.
  - (vii) Accounts of all grantee institutions shall be made available for inspection by the sanctioning authority for audit whenever asked to do so.
  - (viii) The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so and a provision to this effect should invariably be incorporated in all orders sanctioning grants-in-aid.

8. Expenditure of Rs. 177.19 lakhs (Rupees One Crore Seventy Seven Lakh and Nineteen Thousands Only) will be debited to Demand No. 51-Department of School Education and Literacy, 3601-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head), 02-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), 188-Elementary Education-Teachers Training (Minor Head), 02-National Education Mission-Teachers Training (Sub Head), 01-Strengthening of Teacher Training Institutions, 02.01.31-Grants-in-aid General 2016-17.
9. The pattern of grant/expenditure has been approved by the Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with rules and principles of the Scheme as approved by the Ministry of Finance.
10. On receipt of the sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to the Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur, for accrual of credit balance to the State Government. The Principal Accounts Officer may forward a copy of the advice to the Accountant General and Finance Department of the Government of Chhattisgarh along with a copy to the undersigned.
11. The grantee is located in Chhattisgarh Circle of Accounts.
12. This issues with the concurrence of IFD vide their Diary No. 1019/2017-IFD dated 16.03.2017 and IF-II Diary No. 1032/2017-IF.II dated 30.03.2017.
