I am directed to refer to the minutes of TEAB meeting (2017-18) for consideration of Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) of State Government of Chhattisgarh for the year 2017-18 under the Scheme of Teacher Education.

2. In pursuance of Ministry's Sanction Order of even no. dated 01.08.2017 regarding released of 1st installment of Recurring Central Assistance to the State of Chhattisgarh for 2017-18. The detailed institution wise break-up of approved budget, released amount of 1st installment and balance to be released for 2017-18 to the State Govt. of Chhattisgarh is as under:-



I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India to the payment of **Rs. 150.00 lakhs** (Rupees One Crore and Fifty Lakh only) under **General Head** to the Government of Chhattisgarh as 2nd installment of Recurring Central Assistance for 2017-18 to meet the expenditure in respect DIETs, CTES, IASEs, SCERT and MMEs under the Scheme of Teacher Education.
5. The amount sanctioned under **SCSP Heads** is being issued separately.
6. The above grant of Central assistance shall be subject to the following conditions:-
- (i) Central assistance will be utilized in conformity with the guidelines for the scheme circulated to State Governments vide this Department's D.O. letter No.44-2/2012-EE-9, dated 12.07.2012, and any other guidelines that may be circulated by the Deptt. from time to time.
 - (ii) Expenditure on the training programme under other specific schemes (like SSA, EGS/AIE, etc.), shall be met from the funds sanctioned under those schemes and not from the funds sanctioned under Teacher Education Scheme.
 - (iii) A copy of every order of State Government according administrative approval or financial sanction for any item of recurring expenditure (including orders concerning posts) in connection with the above institutions will be endorsed to this Department.
 - (iv) State Government shall abide by the terms & conditions of the MOU executed by the Ministry and the State Government, and any further guidelines which may be issued by the Ministry from time to time.
 - (v) The amount of grant shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance out of the grant, if any, at the end of 2017-18, shall be refunded by the State Government after the close of the financial year unless permission is granted for its being carried forward for utilization for the same purpose during the following financial year.
 - (vi) State Govt. shall regularly submit half-yearly progress cum utilization report under the Teacher Education Scheme. Utilization report of amount being released by this sanction letter shall be forwarded by the State Govt. at the earliest and in any case within three months from close of the financial year.
 - (vii) Accounts of all grantee institutions shall be made available for inspection by the sanctioning authority for audit whenever asked to do so.
 - (viii) The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so and a provision to this effect should invariably be incorporated in all orders sanctioning grants-in-aid.
7. Expenditure of **Rs. 150.00 lakhs** (Rupees One Crore and Fifty Lakh only) will be debited to Demand No. 57-Department of School Education and Literacy, **3601-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head), 06-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head 06), 101-Central Assistance/Share (Minor Head 101), 06-National Education Mission-Teachers Training and Adult Education (Sub Head 06), 02-Strengthening of Teacher Training Institutions (Detailed Head 02), 06.02.31-Grants-in-aid-General 2017-18.**
8. The pattern of grant/expenditure has been approved by the Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with rules and principles of the Scheme as approved by the Ministry of Finance.
