SECTION - A

(Marks: 05)

LO – LE110 - Listens to English words, greetings, polite forms of expression, simple sentences, and responds in English /home language or 'signing' (using sign language).

Activity 1. Locate & say

Students are asked to point out the answer on the chart as they listen to the question

Good morning	**	Sorry	
	Please		Amul
Red	Anandi	Thank You	
	Sorry		Blue

- Q.1 What do you find in the sky?
- Q.2 What do you drink?
- Q.3 What do you say when you get a gift?
- Q.4 Which is a girl's name?
- Q.5 What do you read?
- Q.6 What do you eat with butter?

Instruction: The teacher can make different sets of questions for the pictures/words in the grid for the students. For Each correct answers one mark is given.

Activity 2. Picture reading

The class is divided in to groups. The teacher collects picture cards for action words and mixes them up. These pictures are distributed in groups. Each group is given a set of pictures which are distributed like a game of cards. So, each child gets four or five cards. If they say the name of all the action word he has got correctly, he gets a full score.



e.g. sing, run, dance, jump, swim, skip etc.

Activity 3. Sort them out

Take five trays and label them as FLOWERS, FRUITS, COLORS, BIRDS & ANIMALS. Prepare cards with 5-6 names of flowers, birds, animals, fruits and colors, & mix them up. Now ask the students to find for e.g. A mango from the bunch of cards and place it in the corresponding tray.



Flowers Fruits

LO – LE113 - Uses nouns such as 'boy', 'sun', and prepositions like 'in', 'on', 'under', etc.

Activity 4. Prepositions

The teacher collects picture as shown below and asks the students to use prepositions in simple sentences like

The cat is sitting on the chair. The clock is the table.



Instruction: The teacher can sing the preposition song 'There is a tree, the tree is in the garden, and the green grass grows around' and asks the students to draw a picture as they listen to the song.

Activity 5. Just names

The teacher recites small poems and asks the students to write down/say only the names that they hear. The class can be divided into two groups and scored for the highest number of correct nouns. For example:

Jack and Jill, Went up the hill

To fetch a pail of water;

Jack fell down and broke his crown

And Jill came tumbling after.

Nouns: Jack, Jill, hill, pail, water, crown.

Activity 6. Can you do?

Collect some objects like pens, coloured balls, book, keys, box, on the table Ask the students to do as per the instruction. Eg Place the red ball in the box.

Put the key under the book.
