#### आमुख

किसी भी समाज की शिक्षा उस समाज की आवश्यकताओं और चुनौतियों के परिप्रेक्ष्य में होनी चाहिए। वर्तमान संदर्भों में यह जरूरी है कि बच्चे न केवल राष्ट्र के योग्य नागरिक बने बल्कि वैश्विक नागरिक बन कर सफलता हासिल करें। यह तभी संभव होगा, जब बच्चों में वैश्विक कौशलों का विकास किया जाए, जिससे प्रत्येक बच्चा हुनरमंद, योग्य नागरिक बनकर समाज की उन्नति में अपना योगदान दे सके।

यह आवश्यक हो गया है कि प्रत्येक बच्चे के नजरिये से शिक्षा व्यवस्था का विश्लेषण किया जाए। इस विश्लेषण से उपजे परिणाम विकास का रास्ता तय करने में हमारी मदद करेंगे।

इस दिशा में सार्थक प्रयास आरंभ किए गए। राज्य स्तर पर सर्वप्रथम मंथन कार्यशालाओं का आयोजन किया गया। इन कार्यशालाओं में से एक प्रमुख चुनौती पूरी तीव्रता के साथ उभर कर सामने आई, वह थी, कक्षाओं में आकलन और अध्यापन का अलग—अलग होना। इससे बच्चों की नियमित व सतत् प्रगति का आकलन दुष्कर कार्य सिद्ध हुआ, साथ ही बच्चों के लिए सही समय पर उपचारात्मक शिक्षण (Remediation) में भी कठिनाईयाँ आई।

आकलन यदि सीखने–सिखाने की प्रक्रिया का आवश्यक अंग बन जाता है तो बच्चे की प्रगति की नियमित जानकारी ली जा सकेगी, इस जानकारी के विश्लेषण के आधार पर यह पता लगाना संभव हो सकेगा कि कहाँ और किन क्षेत्रों में किस तरह के उपचार या सुधार कार्यों की आवश्यकता है।

इस रणनीति के तहत राज्य आकलन केन्द्र की स्थापना कर आगामी तीन वर्षों में सुधार, प्रगति व गुणवत्ता संवर्धन हेतु लक्ष्य निर्धारित किए गए :

सत्र 2019–20 में बेसलाइन आकलन
 सत्र 2020–21 में मिडलाइन आकलन
 सत्र 2021–22 में एण्डलाइन आकलन

इस तरह लक्ष्य को अंजाम तक पहुँचाने की पूर्ण तैयारी की गई। समूची शिक्षा व्यवस्था के प्रत्येक अंग को रचनात्मक, सावधिक एवं योगात्मक आकलन के लिए तैयार किया गया है। विषयवार लर्निंग आउटकम्स आधारित अभ्यास पुस्तिकाएँ, प्रश्न बैंक, रूब्रिक्स तैयार कर स्कूलों में भेजने एवं प्रशिक्षणों की सशक्त व्यवस्थाएँ राज्य स्तर पर की गई हैं। हमारा यही प्रयास हमारी गुणवत्तापूर्ण शैक्षणिक विकास यात्रा को सार्थकता प्रदान करेगा।

इसी क्रम में यह शैक्षिक सामग्री आपको सौंपी जा रही है। विश्वास है कि बच्चों में विभिन्न कुशलताओं के विकास करने में यह सामग्री आपको सहयोग प्रदान करेगी।
